Change in Membership Dues?

The Executive Committee (EC) met on October 27, 2022 to discuss an opportunity to restructure the club dues for 2023-24.

The EC voted to make the following motion to the club for approval:

"All members shall pay \$25 annual dues instead of the current \$30 Active, \$20 Honorary, and \$35 Sustaining."

Explanation: At the current time the Club can sustain this change based on income, expenses, and the reserve held in the Club treasury account. Current membership is at 79 members. 48 are Active, 16 are Honorary, and 15 are Sustaining. This notice serves as the written notification of the intent to each voting member as listed in the bylaws listed below. A vote will occur at the December 12, 2022 meeting.

The Club Bylaws Article VIII Section 1: Each active, sustaining, and honorary member shall pay annual dues as determined by the club. The amount of dues may be changed by a two-thirds vote of the voting members present at any regular meeting with previous written notification of the intent to each voting member.

According to our bylaws, all members must receive notice of any motion to change our bylaws, whether they are a voting member (Active or Honorary) or a non-voting member (Sustaining). This posting serves as that notification. Those members who do not receive email have been sent the above notice via USPS.



Hospitality Committee

At the October 17th meeting a motion was passed to retain the current Hospitality Committee guidelines with the following additions:

The President of the Garden Club of Johnstown is excused from hospitality duty during their term of office. The Executive Committee is excused from serving as <u>Chairmen</u> of the Hospitality Committee during their terms of office but will continue to serve as members on the Hospitality Committees.
